ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

The *Bulletin* newsletter was published annually from 1973 to 1979 and was edited by André LeBlanc of Champlain College in St. Lambert, Quebec. The newsletter provided members of the Committee on Canadian Labour History with information on new publications, dates of meetings, minutes and reports of meetings, and research interests of the members.

The six to twelve page newsletter had three different titles during the years 1973-1975: the first issue was titled *Committee on Canadian Labour History, Bulletin No.1*, the second issue was titled *Canadian Labour History/Histoire Ouvrière Canadienne, No.2*, and all subsequent five issues were titled *Canadian Labour History/Histoire Ouvrière Canadienne: Newsletter of the Committee On Canadian Labour History.* In 1975, the newsletter was launched with the new title: *Bulletin*. The new *Bulletin* included review essays, archival sources and various reports.

The first issue of *Labour/Le Travail* appeared in 1976 and included the *Bulletin*. The journal remained an annual publication until 1980 when it expanded to a twice-a-year publication. Coinciding with the new *Labour/Le Travail* format, the *Bulletin* suspended publication with issue eight, in the autumn of 1979. This last regular issue of the *Bulletin* was entirely devoted to a bibliography of secondary sources in Canadian labour history.

CUSTODIAL HISTORY:

In 2007 Athabsaca University Press took over the publication of *Labour/Le Travail* from Memorial University of St. John's, Newfoundland. The journal's archives came to

Athabasca University as well and were donated to the Thomas A. Edge Archives & Special Collections by the Canadian Committee on Labour History.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

Series consists of administrative records of the newsletter including correspondence, subscriptions and mailing lists, manuscripts, proofs and production matters. The series also consists of all eight issues of the bulletin newsletter.
