APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Funds are available through the Research Centre for research conducted by Athabasca University graduate program students' to assist in partially covering **Data Management/Analysis Software** costs incurred while completing a thesis/dissertation. Examples of anticipated expenses that a student may incur include purchasing licenses (or upgrade) for statistical software such as SPSS, NVIVO, ATLAS.ti, etc.

Eligibility

Students currently enrolled and in good standing in an Athabasca University program of graduate study may be eligible to receive reimbursement up to **\$250 per annum**, for the purchase of data management/analysis software that has been **approved by the student's supervisor** (with a maximum of two submissions per annum.)

Funds will be available during both a student's Master's and Doctoral programs, if applicable.

Supervisor Support

All applicants must obtain support from their thesis/dissertation or project supervisor. Support from the thesis/dissertation or project supervisor affirms that the software is needed for completion of a thesis/ dissertation or project.

Reimbursement

Graduate student award recipients are required to submit a signed <u>Reimbursement Claim Form for Non-AU Employees</u>, along with original receipts and proof of purchase.

Receipts must be dated within the fiscal year (April 1 to March 31) in which the award was received.
