The successful candidate will work with, and directly report to, Dr. Hussein Alzyoud & Dr. Eduardo Ordonez-Ponce at Athabasca University. Dr. Alzyoud will provide adequate training for the participant recruitment and scheduling, and the data collection, analysis, and dissemination activities that will be required.



## **Qualifications:**

The total hours for this position are 35 hours per month over 14 months. The weekly hours will vary but may be no more than 9 hours per week. Rate of pay commensurate with experience and collective agreement provisions. The successful candidate with a minimum of a master's degree (Ph.D. preferred) in Economics, or directly related field such as Economic community development, Planning, or other Social Sciences related field. Along with the relevant academic credentials mentioned above, this position requires excellent communication, organizational, and administration skills. prefer someone based in Alberta, incase we may need to travel to the communities.

In light of the current COVID 19 context, work for this position will take place remotely. However, should circumstances change during the time period of this work, there will be opportunities for the successful candidate to work in person with the research team.
