Description of Award

This award is available to Alberta Aboriginal students who are entering one of the specified undergraduate degree programs at AU.

Conditions of Eligibility

An applicant must meet the following criteria to be eligible to apply for this award:

- Be a current AU undergraduate degree student entering their first year of studies in one of the following programs:
 - Bachelor of Commerce
 - Bachelor of Management
 - Bachelor of Science
- Preference given to students entering their first year of studies. (Students in all years of study are eligible to apply)
- Student has “full time” undergraduate program status;
 - 3 three credit courses if in receipt of Student Financial assistance.
 - 4 three credit courses if self-funded.
- Be a resident of Alberta and of Aboriginal ancestry (Status Indian/First Nations, Non-Status Indian/First Nations, Metis or Inuit) as defined by the applicant’s Indigenous nation of origin. .
- Demonstration of career objectives and/or community activities.
- Preference will be given to applicants who have not been a previous recipient of the award.
