The purpose of this policy is to formally acknowledge an individual and/or group for exemplary service to Athabasca University.

Definitions

Honorary Awards Committee A standing committee of the Board that has full authority to select recipients for honorary degrees, recipients of the Order of Athabasca University, candidates for other honorary awards and other speakers for convocation.

Policy Statements

The Order of Athabasca University may be awarded annually to an individual and/or group having a record of exemplary service to Athabasca University or to the community or society while representing Athabasca University as determined by the Honorary Awards Committee.
